



Retirement from a Location in the Archdiocese Cincinnati Benefit Plans

The Archdiocese of Cincinnati does not offer Health, Prescription Drug, or Dental Insurance to Pre-age 65 Retirees or Post-age 65 Retirees. This option was terminated effective December 31, 2016. The change, effective August 31, 2016, affected all past, current, and future retirees.

If you currently have health insurance through your parish or school, that coverage will end on the last day of the month in which you terminate employment. Three months ahead of your retirement date, please plan to apply for Medicare Parts A, B, and purchase a supplemental or advantage plan that has prescription drug coverage or better known as Medicare Part D. The Medicare website is very informative at www.medicare.gov

There are many options to find a supplemental or advantage plan through an area broker. The Archdiocese has referred employees to RetireMED®iQ (a program administered by MB Senior Solutions), to help future retirees (age 65 and older) navigate to a new plan. RetireMED®iQ's trained staff will meet with you personally to show you options for retirement coverage in addition to your Medicare Part A and Part B. You may purchase life conversion insurance on the date you have loss in coverage. You must apply for conversion coverage within 31 days after loss of coverage. Contact The Standard at 1.800.378.4668 within 31 days of employment termination for a Portability and Conversion Application and full description on the amounts you may be entitled to convert.

Eligible employees are 100% vested and independently manage their 401(k) account held at Fifth Third.
